



Truth Telling & Celebrating History

Although Tulsa's Black Wall Street is often cited as a prime example of Black economic empowerment and the potential for African-American communities to create their own opportunities and wealth, it is important to acknowledge that it is not the only instance in history of the significance and power of Black economic self determination. In fact, many Black communities prospered economically between the Civil War and the conclusion of Reconstruction, Solely on the strength of the Black dollar.

In producing the New Haven Black Wall Stret Festival, we have made it a priority to also consider the ways in which we honor and acknowledge other historic districts. We have created a legacy page on our website to tribute a selection of neighborhoods. By doing so we not only recognize their significant contributions to Black economic self determination, but also engage in truth-telling and reconciliation about the injustices and harm that these communities faces as a result of systemic racism. This can help us to build a more inclusive and equitable society, one that values and uplifts the stories and experiences of all people.
